Katie was patient, kind, loyal, hard working; a single mom with a million-dollar smile that lit up the room. A Speech Language Pathologist, she dedicated her professional life to helping children with special needs. Killed by a drunk driver, Katie's life was tragically cut short in February of 2006 as she was driving home from Children's Hospital with her 10-year old daughter, Emma, who was seriously injured.
